

Pittsburg's Housing Indicators

- Median sale prices of homes continue to rise (\$440,000), with a 11% increase over last year's median sales price (\$395,000)
- Average price per square foot has increased from \$104 to \$278 over the past 7 years
- Foreclosures and short sales of single-family homes continue to fall. In 2017 distressed sales accounted for only 3% of all sales, compared to 5% from 2016




Business Licenses issued increased 30% since 2008


