ATTACHMENT A

Frontage Road Trail Pre-Bid Q & A- 10-27-2023

1. Q: We have concerns regarding the RFI response 34.j. "Contractor shall assume that overexcavation and lime treatment is necessary in the areas of the trail and vehicular pavement, curb and gutter, vertical curb, and concrete ramps.."

Where this is referenced in the specifications it references the large areas of cuts in the sportsfield leading us to believe this isn't for this project. The referenced specification section 31 05 13 mentions over-excavating 3 feet below subgrade in the hardscape areas. If we're required to over-excavate to this depth, table the material, and limetreat this will be a huge cost pushing the project cost well above the engineers estimate.

Furthermore, if we are required to cut 3', and table the material, we would expect to get paid under the rough grading bid item which would now have a bust.

If the 3' overexcavation is waived, we'll still be required to overexcavate and table the material 1' as most of the hardscape widths are too small to limetreat without tabling. Not common to limetreat a trail like this, especially with the effect the lime can have on the planting.

Please reconsider this requirement.

A: The over excavation or lime treatment requirement shall be removed. Contractor shall scarify and recompact the subbase material to 90% Relative compaction in areas of the trail and vehicular pavement, curb and gutter, vertical curb, and concrete ramps. If the compaction is not met the contractor shall repair the area with 6 inches of aggregate base with geotextile fabric.

2. Q: Can I receive a plan holders' list for the referenced project above?

A: Currently there are no contractors on the plan holders list. Check with the Bid Boards for additional information.

3. Q: Many of the bid items which addendum 3 said were added weren't added to the bid form. Furthermore, the pay item description for the vertical curb and valley gutter didn't make it into the addendum.

 - 2. In event any unit price quoted appears to compare unfavorably with currently established prices for type of work, City reserves the right to require quoted price to be substantiated or adjusted prior to execution of contract.
 - 3. Unit prices listed on the Bid Form for the following items shall constitute full and complete compensation for each unit, and shall include cost of temporary and administrative work, permits, bonds, insurance, sales taxes, overhead, profit and every other expense, direct or indirect, incident to accomplishment of work under each item.

- 3.1 MEASUREMENT
 - A. Measurement of quantities for payment shall be made or determined by City's Inspector.
 - 1. Volume of any material shall be based on information included with Drawings and additional measurements obtained by Inspector, or by combination of such information, or in a manner which, in the opinion of the Inspector, is best suited to obtain necessary accuracy.

- 2. In case of unit prices based upon weight measurement, certified weight tickets shall be supplied at time of delivery of materials.
- 3. Excess materials delivered to the site, but not incorporated in the work, shall not be paid for.
- 3.2 UNIT PRICE ITEMS
 - A. Bid Item No 1 Clear and Grub:
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By square foot, unless specified otherwise.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Clearing and grubbing shall be paid for at the contract square foot price, which includes full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all work involved in clearing and grubbing as shown on the plans, as specified and as directed by the Project Manager, including the removal and disposal of all the resulting material.

 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By per square foot, unless specified otherwise.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: The Contract square foot price for "Demolition AC Paving" shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for doing all work involved in demolition of AC paving, including remove asphalt paving and base to design subgrade, and other items of work as specified in the plans, Standard Specification and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
 - 3. Demolition AC Paving includes removal, off-haul, and legal disposal of incidental items included in the scope as specified in the plans, Standard Specification and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
 - C. Bid Item No 3 Demolition- Curb and Gutter:
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By lineal foot, unless specified otherwise.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: The Contract linear foot price paid for "Demolition Curb and Gutter" shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for doing all work involved in curb and gutter demolition, including demolition and removal of curb and gutter and base to design subgrade as specified in the plans and per the Standard Specification and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
 - 3. Demolition- Curb and Gutter includes removal, off-haul, and legal disposal of incidental items included in the scope as specified in the plans, Standard

Specification and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.

- D. Bid Item No 4 Demolition- Utilities:
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By lineal foot, unless specified otherwise.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: The Contract linear foot price paid for "Demolition -Utilities" shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for doing all work involved in utility demolition, including terminating and removing utilities to be demolished as specified in the plans, Standard Specification and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
 - 3. Demolition Utilities includes removal, off-haul, and legal disposal of incidental items included in the scope as specified in the plans, Standard Specification and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
- E. Bid Item No 5 Sawcut
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By lineal foot, unless specified otherwise.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: The Contract linear foot price paid for "Sawcut" shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals for doing all work involved in sawcutting as specified in the plans, Standard Specification and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
 - 3. Sawcut includes removal, off-haul, and legal disposal of incidental items included in the scope as specified in the plans, Standard Specification and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
- F. Bid Item No 6 Tree Protection
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By Each as specified in the bid form complete in place, unless otherwise specified in the Contract Documents.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Shall include but not limited to full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals including not limited Tree protection. coordination but to with City Representative/Arborist, temporary irrigation, supplemental watering, mulching, tree pruning, landscape planting and irrigation replacement of existing work which is damaged, and for doing all work involved in Landscape Preservation as shown on the plans, as specified and as directed by the Engineer, including the removal and disposal of all the resulting material.
 - 3. Tree Protection includes standard construction fencing and posts. Includes review and approval by the Engineer.

- G. Bid Item No 7 Tree Removal
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By Each as specified in the bid form complete in place, unless otherwise specified in the Contract Documents.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Shall include but not limited to full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all work involved in tree removal and stump removal as shown on the plans, as specified, and as directed by the Engineer, including the removal and disposal of all the resulting material.
 - 3. This bid item is for the removal and disposal of all trees with a trunk diameter size of six inches or greater including the root balls.
- H. Bid Item No 8 Rough Grading
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By cubic yard of the rough graded, movement of earthwork, and compacted soil.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Includes excavating existing subsoil, verifying if existing subsoil meets the select fill requirements, supplying select fill, materials, stockpiling, maintaining, moving, placing, rough grading, and compacting of select fills as specified in the plans, project soils report, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
 - 3. <u>Rough Grading shall include moving, spreading, and leveling of</u> excess material on site as directed by the City's Representative.
- I. Bid Item No 9 Fine Grading
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By square foot of the compacted and fine graded soil.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Fine Grading shall be paid for at the contract square foot price, which includes full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all work involved in fine grading as shown on the plans, project soils report, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as specified and as directed by the Project Manager.
- J. Bid Item No 10 Asphalt Pavement -Trail
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By ton and shall be based on certified weight-meters certificates showing gross, net weight and the type and grading of the mix for each load unless specified otherwise on the Bid Form.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Shall include but not limited to furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, incidentals, excavation, samples, mockups,

pre-emergent, AC pavement, stabilizer, compaction testing, sub-base preparation, and for doing all the work involved in installing Trail Pavement, complete in place as shown on the plans, project soils report, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.

- K. Bid Item No 11 Asphalt Pavement -Vehicular
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By ton and shall be based on certified weight-meters certificates showing gross, net weight and the type and grading of the mix for each load unless specified otherwise on the Bid Form.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Shall include but not limited to furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, incidentals, excavation, samples, mockups, pre-emergent, AC pavement, stabilizer, compaction testing, sub-base preparation, and for doing all the work involved in installing Trail Pavement, complete in place as shown on the plans, project soils report, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
- L. Bid Item No 12 Aggregate Base
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By the cubic yard as specified in the bid form. Quantities of aggregates shall be calculated on the basis of dimensions shown on the plans. No allowance shall be made for aggregate rejected or placed outside said dimensions unless otherwise order by the Project Manager.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Includes full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals, in installing aggregate base, stockpiling, scarifying subgrade surface, placing where required, watering, dust palliative, leveling, compacting and certifying the top of aggregate base design grades as shown on the plans, project soils report, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
- M. Bid Item No 13 Concrete Curb and Gutter
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By linear feet for concrete curb and gutters. Concrete pads around utility facilities and miscellaneous concrete footings are incidental to the bid item most closely related to and no separate compensation allowed therefor. Retaining curbs at curb ramps are not measured and are considered incidental to the measurement of curb ramps. Curb and gutter adjacent to the curb ramp shall be measured separately. Adjacent deep lift AC shall be included in the bid item.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals including subgrade preparation, excavation, base preparation, forms, reinforcing, concrete, accessories, placing concrete, finishing

concrete, expansion joints, weakened plane joints, scoring joints, curing, removal of all forms, and testing as shown on the plans, project soils report, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.

- N. Bid Item No 14 Curb Ramp
 - Basis of Measurement: By unit, Each, for Concrete Curb Ramps. Concrete pads around utility facilities and miscellaneous concrete footings are incidental to the bid item most closely related to, and no separate compensation allowed therefor. <u>Truncated domes, adjacent deep lift AC</u> <u>plug, clearing and grubbing, and adjacent landscaping/irrigation are considered incidental and as part of the pay item for Curb Ramps.</u>
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Includes all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals including clearing and grubbing, subgrade preparation, excavation, base preparation, forms, reinforcing, concrete, accessories, placing concrete, finishing concrete, expansion joints, weakened plane joints, scoring joints, curing, removal of all forms, testing, installation of the truncated domes, deep lift AC plug, and replacement landscaping/irrigation as shown on the plans, project soils report, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
- O. Bid Item No 15 Striping -Thermoplastic
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By lineal foot as specified in the bid form complete in place, unless otherwise specified in the Contract.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Includes full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals required for installation as shown on the plans, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
- P. Bid Item No 16 Pedestrian Concrete Paving REMOVED
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By Square Foot as specified in the bid form complete in place, unless otherwise specified in the Contract.
 - 2. Basis of Payment: Shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, incidentals, excavation, subgrade preparation, aggregate base, base preparation, compaction testing, Portland cement mix, finishes, sand, reinforcing steel, accessories, mock-up panels of each paving type, placing concrete, finishing concrete, expansion joints, weakened plane joints, scoring joints, curing, removal of all forms, testing, and for doing all the work involved in in installing Pedestrian Concrete Paving, complete in place as required by the contract documents and as directed by the Engineer.

- Q. Bid Item No 17 Redwood Header

Basis of Payment: The contract price paid per linear foot for Storm Drainage piping shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in furnishing and installing Storm Drainage Piping, complete in place including bends, elbows or other pipe fittings, saw cut, excavating to required elevations, all utility trenching work as specified in <u>Section 31 23 16 Utility</u> <u>Trenching</u>, removing excavated materials, dewatering, bedding, cradles, backfill and backfill material, pipe installation with warning tape, restoration and disposing of materials outside the Right-of-Way and connections to existing or new storm drainage mains and manholes.
- T. Bid Item No 19 A Storm Drain Piping 6" Solid
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: Storm Drainage Piping shall be measured by linear foot of pipe installed, measured from edge of structure to edge of structure for various pipe materials and various sizes irrespective of the depth of pipes.

- 2. Basis of Payment: The contract price paid per linear foot for Storm Drainage piping shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in furnishing and installing Storm Drainage Piping, complete in place including bends, elbows or other pipe fittings, saw cut, excavating to required elevations, all utility trenching work as specified in <u>Section 31 23 16 Utility</u> <u>Trenching</u>, removing excavated materials, dewatering, bedding, cradles, backfill and backfill material, pipe installation with warning tape, restoration and disposing of materials outside the Right-of-Way and connections to existing or new storm drainage mains and manholes.
- U. Bid Item No 20 6" Storm Drain Cleanout
 - 1. Basis of Measurement: By Each for storm drain cleanouts.
 - Basis of Payment: Includes sawcut, excavation, including all utility trenching work as specified in <u>Section 31 23 16 – Utility Trenching</u>, traffic-rated box, riser, accessories, concrete collar, tests, backfill and surface restoration as shown on the plans, project soils report, Standard Specifications and the Technical Specifications, and as directed by the Project Manager.
- V. Bid Item No 21 Storm Drain Bubbler
