Attachment A – Pre-Bid Questions and Responses

Q1: The bid documents seem to be missing spec section 01 71 23 – Construction Surveying As there seems to be a number of requirements for Contractor supplied professionally licensed surveyor – would the city consider including this specification?

A: Section 01 71 23- Construction Surveying is part of the City standard specifications which are located on the City's website. Payment for construction surveying shall be considered to be part of all other bid items and no further compensation is allowed therefore.

Q2: Does the City have an area where the soil could be temporarily stockpiled?

A: The project shows a proposed staging area that may be used for stockpiling of material. This would need to be evaluated with the City prior to construction to make sure that dirt material does not migrate at any time to the adjacent creek right of way.

Q3: Would the City consider carrying the cost to sleeve the transmission lines prior to start of Construction?

A: No, the contractor shall coordinate with the Utility agencies during construction.

Q4: Would the City be coordinating insulating blankets for the construction lines during construction?

A: This would be a coordination item for the contractor based on discussion with the utility company based on means and methods of construction for the contractor.
