1. Pittsburg General Housing Element - Maurice Brenyah-Addow -The City of Pittsburg has released as of March 1<sup>st</sup> a 6<sup>th</sup> Draft Housing Cycle Element Program. They will be updating the housing plan for the 2023-2031 housing plan period. 2052 units are planned for the 2023-2031 period, with units ranging between extremely low income – above moderate income.
